GENERAL INFORMATION

- Term pass - \$90 for 10 weeks. Some terms will be shorter in length, therefore the cost will be reduced accordingly. (Only \$9 per week and secures your child's spot)
- Casual entry - only available for first time attendance each term at \$10.50 per session, term passes must be purchased after first casual attendance.
- Early bird discount - purchase a term pass by Sunday 23 July 2017 and receive 10% off.
- Term pass family discount - register two or more children from the same family (siblings only) and receive 10% off. This applies only when registering children at the same time (does not apply for a child registered in two or more clinics) This offer can be used in conjunction with the early bird discount provided it is paid prior to the end date of Sunday 23 July 2017.
- Clinics frequently fill up so we strongly encourage casuals to arrive 15 minutes early. Term passes are available subject to availability. Purchasing a term pass will guarantee your child placement in a clinic.
- Registrations open 28 days prior to commencement of first clinic/program.
- Registrations available online wanneroo.wa.gov.au/kingwayindoorstadium Payments can be made over the phone on 9408 1920 or at the stadium.

PLEASE NOTE

- A minimum number of children is required to run the clinic depending on the clinic type. In some cases this cannot be determined until the day of the clinic.
- Programs do not run on public holidays.

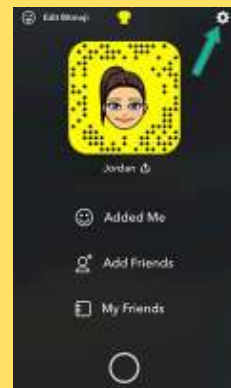
Turning off location mapping on SNAPCHAT

The latest update of SnapChat now allows the app to track your child's location, marking their location on a map for other users to see. In the photo I have attached below, you can see my exact location of where I was earlier today. The map will provide live updates of your child's current location as they move

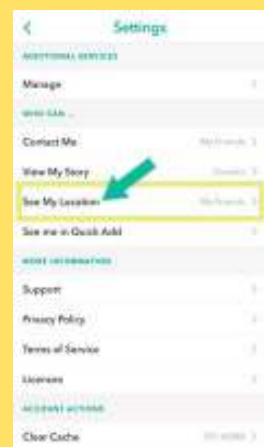
To help you turn this dangerous feature off, here are my step-by-step instructions (with pictures):

1. Open the SnapChat app on your child's device,

2. The app will open on the camera screen. Use your finger to scroll down. This screen below will appear. In the top right hand corner, click on the Settings button (the gear icon).



3. Scroll down through the settings and under the 'Who can..' section, click on 'See my location'.



4. Turn on 'Ghost Mode',
